BIOGRAPHY

Khaled started his career as a Loss Adjuster in 2005 and worked for 7 years with AHLA-Egypt Engineering Company, the associate in Egypt for Crawford & Company. During that time, Khaled conducted many industrial pre-risk surveys and handled claims in different classes of insurance, the most prominent of which was assisting in one of the largest fire claims in Egypt, which is EMBEE International Garment Company (USD 26.5 Million).
